The Patient Hardship Fund provides vital support to BCH patients experiencing unexpected financial challenges after a medical emergency. Thanks to your generosity through the Employee Giving Campaign, we recently helped a local patient in need.

A Beatrice factory worker was injured on the job, resulting in the loss of both his employment and housing. While working to rebuild his life, he needed transportation assistance. Because of the Patient Hardship Fund, we were able to provide the support he needed to move toward stability.

Greatest Need Fund

Did you know that donations to the Greatest Need Fund play a crucial role in supporting the grants we offer each Fall? In 2025, the BCH Foundation awarded \$247,624 in grants to 14 BCH **Departments and Clinics** and \$58,500 to Gage County **Community Nonprofits**, for a total of **\$306,124** in funding!

These grants are already making an impact. At BCH, funding provided new life-saving equipment such as Zoll defibrillators, an infant CPAP device, a bladder scanner, a DaVinci surgical camera, and so much more. In the community, grants supported projects including a 15-passenger van for the YMCA's child care program, housing assistance through Hope Crisis Center, and AED's for local organizations. These are just a few of the ways donor generosity is reaching families across Gage County.
