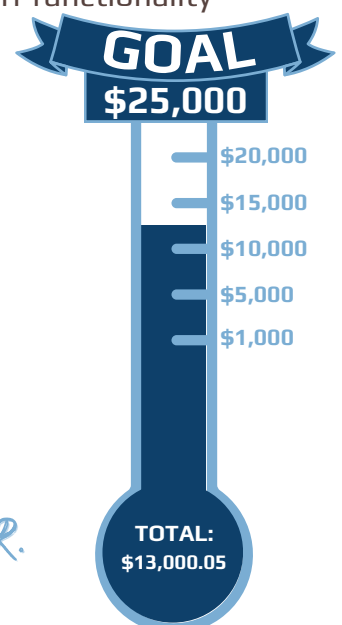

Recently, BCH cared for a homeless patient living outside in his wheelchair after being unable to remain at the Lincoln Mission due to the complexity of his medical needs, including flaccid hemiplegia, a prior stroke, and diabetes. Thanks to the BCH Patient Hardship Fund - and the generosity of you, our incredible BCH employees- we were able to provide him with two nights in a hotel while he waited for housing paperwork to be finalized at Carstens Garden. This short-term support helped ease a deeply stressful gap in care and gave him dignity and comfort during a vulnerable time.
